As a graduate trainee at the STEG Stadt Entwicklung in Stuttgart, a wide variety of roles were performed in the city planning and restoration department.

Apart from the creation of urban technical reports for various cities and towns slated for renovation in the states of Baden Württemberg and Saxony (former East Germany) and which included the organization of the maintenance of public monuments; the design and creation of multiple brochures, competition and convention posters and graphic works for STEG, these works were instrumental in the award of the Gold and Silver Medals for the company in 1993 for the display of renovations for the republic wide competition on 'Whole Cities Slated for Renovation' for the cities of Görlitz and Torgau.

The awards for the cities of Görlitz and Torgau were largely dependant on the concentrated team effort of two separate teams, both lead by one of STEG's senior architects as city planners and each supported by Linda A. Louison as Assistant responsible for the small and immense sizes of presentation works of the projects, coordination of all brochures and measured content. Both the architectural work and the presentation methods were deciding factors in the acquisition of the medals.

Prior to securing the awards for the STEG, an award was also secured for the city planning works for the town of Öhringen (City Market Square and the West Castle).

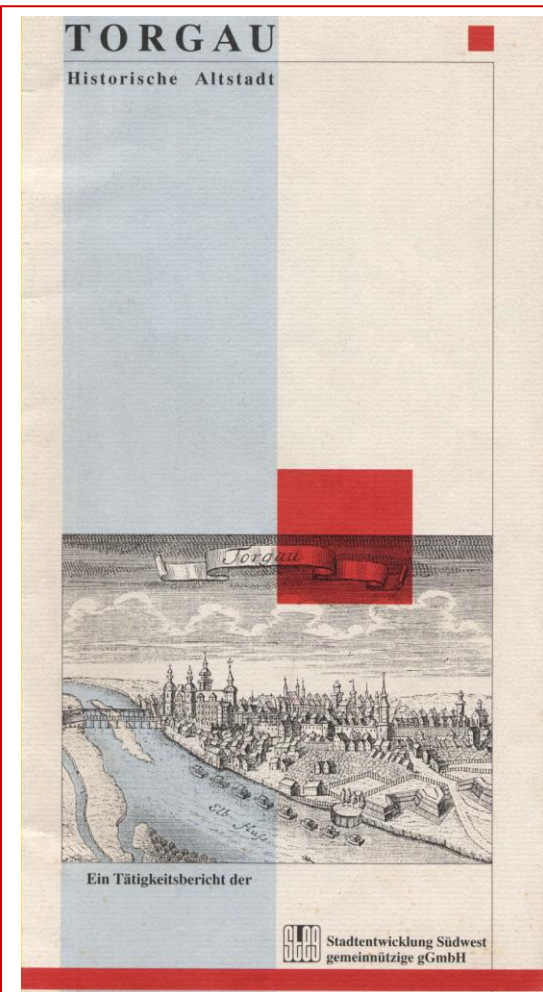
